Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: • Social Security Number • Credit history • Income • Overdraft history • Payment history • Credit card or other debt When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.		
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons 1st Bank Yuma chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does 1st Bank Yuma protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.		
How does 1st Bank Yuma collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Apply for a loan Provide employment information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies. 		
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Nonaffiliates	filiatesCompanies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial an non-financial companies.• 1st Bank Yuma does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.		
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <i>1st Bank Yuma doesn't jointly market.</i>
